- Are between the ages of 30 to 85 years old.

- Are able to complete an accurate home diary.

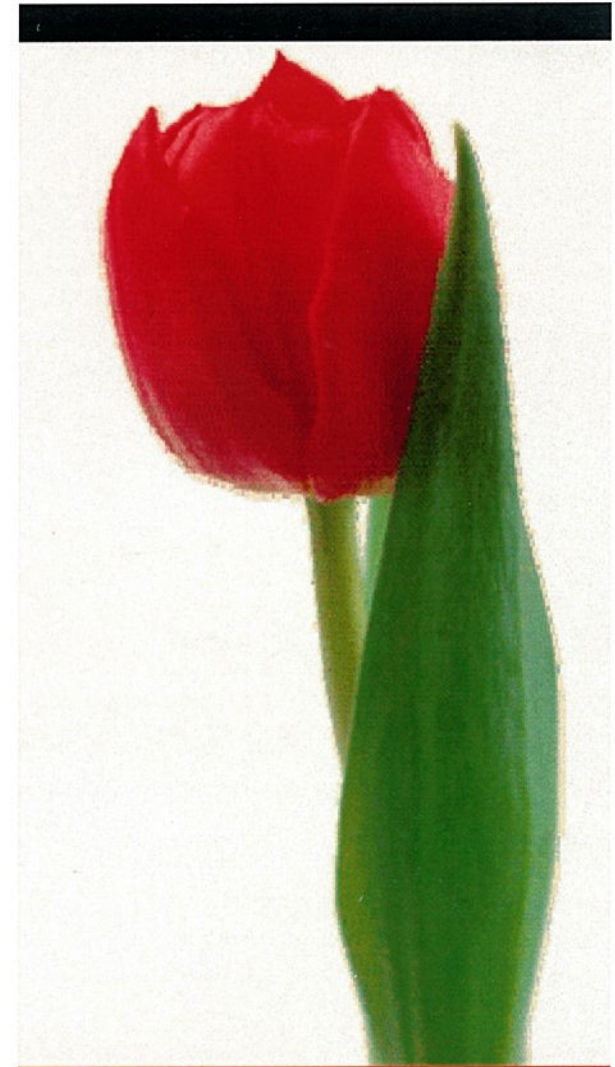

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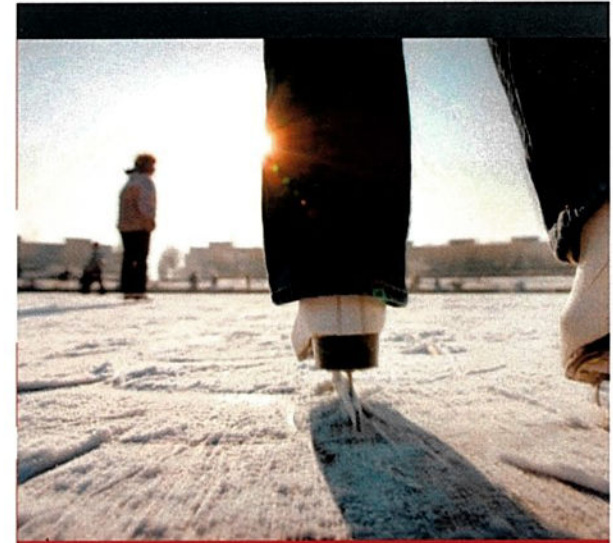
